
FLOW CHART 12: ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT PROCESS - HERITAGE CONSERVATION DISTRICTS (PART V) - Designation of a Heritage Conservation Study Area under section 40.1*

Council may, by by-law designate an area as a heritage conservation study area for a period of up to one year. s.40.1(1)



^{*}Where the designation of a study area ceases to be in effect, Council shall not pass a by-law designating another study area that includes an area that was part of the previously designated study area for three years. See section 40.1 (6)

^{**}Council is not required to enact a by-law simply because it is undertaking a study. The purpose of the by-law is to ensure that changes in the character of the area do not occur during the period of the study
